5.	BHDG Updates	Update	HCA is looking to add new value “04 – No Public Funding” to the 140 Funding transaction for the Type of Funding Support field. As a reminder, you should not be sending 140 transactions on traditional “Crisis only” clients – if they are receiving other GCBH-funded services (block grant funding, SUD, IP services, etc.) then you must submit a 140 transaction to GCBH. This change to “04 – No Public Funding” should only be submitted to us for clients that should have a 140 transaction, and most of those using this code would most likely be due to a change in coverage mid-treatment. 7.	GCBH Updates	Update	We have been working through a lot of audits the last two months; mostly from the MCOs, but we do have TEAMonitoring right now as well from HCA. The legislature this last session passed HB 1813 which now means that Medicaid Crisis Stabilization services (HCPCS: S9485, S9495, and H2019) will be reported through the ASOs starting on 7/1/26. We will let you know when our test system will be ready to receive test files for crisis stabilization.	Kelly Nortrom
